

CALVIN DYCK — *D.M.A., Violin*

Calvin Dyck started music on the accordion at age 5 and the violin at age 8. Despite a college aptitude test recommending a career as a "tug-boat captain", Calvin went on to get his doctorate in violin from the University of Southern California.

He is in demand as a violin teacher and adjudicator, and performs around the world with his interactive shows "The Golden Violin" and "Moscow to Madrid". His eclectic career has taken him to surprising places — from playing in Cuba to dog sledding in Whitehorse. Currently Concertmaster of the Vancouver Island Symphony, he also free lances with North Shore Sinfonia, the Vancouver Opera Orchestra and the Vancouver Symphony Orchestra.

Calvin has recorded 3 CDs for MCC Supportive care services *Meditation, This Shining Night, and One Small Child*. His Fourth cd "*The Dancing Violin*" will be released in November, 2006
