

# Trophies and Plaques

## General Trophy

**Tom Lee Music Trophy** will be presented to the “Overall Best Performer of All Divisions”.

**Best Performance of a Canadian Work** will be presented annually for an outstanding performance of a Canadian work, on the recommendation of the adjudicators.

**Richmond Music Festival Gala Award Trophy** will be presented annually to the most outstanding performer in all divisions. The recipient of this award will be selected from the performers at the Gala Concert by the panel of adjudicators.

## Piano Division

**Class 1024 Trophy** for highest mark, 8 years and under, Piano Repertoire.

**Class 1026 Trophy** for highest mark, 9 years and under, Piano Repertoire.

**Class 1035 Trophy** for highest mark, Intermediate Concert Group.

**Class 1048 Trophy** for highest mark, Grade 8 Multiple Parts.

**Medallions** will be presented annually to the competitors with the highest mark in each of the Classes 1001-1004; 1011-1014 and 1201-1204. *Donated by Martha Hau.*

**Most Outstanding Young Pianist Trophy** will be presented annually to the competitor with the highest mark in Class 1022, 7 years and under, Piano Repertoire.

**Vic. O. Cristobal Trophy** will be presented annually to the competitors with the highest mark of the Piano Ensemble Classes.

“Most Promising Performer” in the Piano Division. Presented annually by the *Richmond Music Festival*.

“**Most Outstanding Pianist under 12 years of age**” will be presented to the of the adjudicators’ choice.

“**Most Outstanding Talent Plaque**” will be presented annually to the competitor who, in the opinion of the adjudicator, shows the most outstanding talent in the Intermediate Piano Division.

## String Division

**Charles and Thelma Lyle Memorial Trophies** will be presented annually to the String player and Pianist with the highest marks overall out of Classes 3090 – 3098, String Sonata Class.

“Most Promising Performer” in the String Division. Presented annually by the *Richmond Music Festival*.

“**Most Outstanding Talent Plaque**” will be presented annually to the competitor who, in the opinion of the adjudicator, shows the most outstanding talent in the Intermediate String Division.

## Voice Division

## Woodwind Division

“**Most Outstanding Talent Plaque**” will be presented annually to the competitor who, in the opinion of the adjudicator, shows the most outstanding talent in the Intermediate Woodwind Division.
